Anchorage, Alaska Grades 1st - 3rd

3. Anchorage is the largest city in Alaska, if the population is doubled, how many people would live in the city?
4. There are so many moose living in Anchorage. A male moose can weigh between 840 and 1,500 pounds, while a female moose only weighs at the most around 790 lbs. What is the difference in the weight of the largest male and female moose?
5. Alaska is famous for its fishing especially with a fish called the Pacific Salmon. These fish are caught for sport, but are also sold around the world. If you caught 2 average weight Chinook Salmon how much would they weigh altogether?
